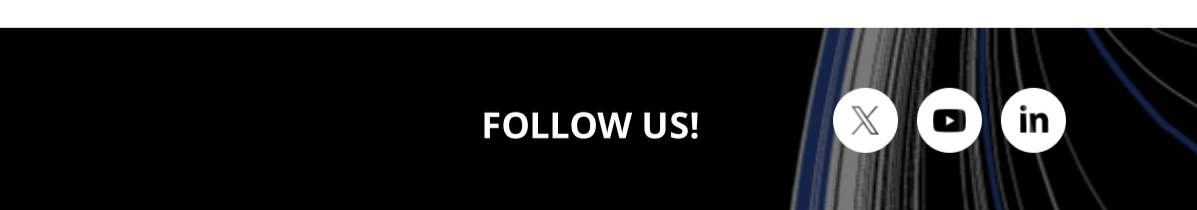
The CISO of tomorrow: preparing for the worst in the age of AI and increasingly complex cyber threats
