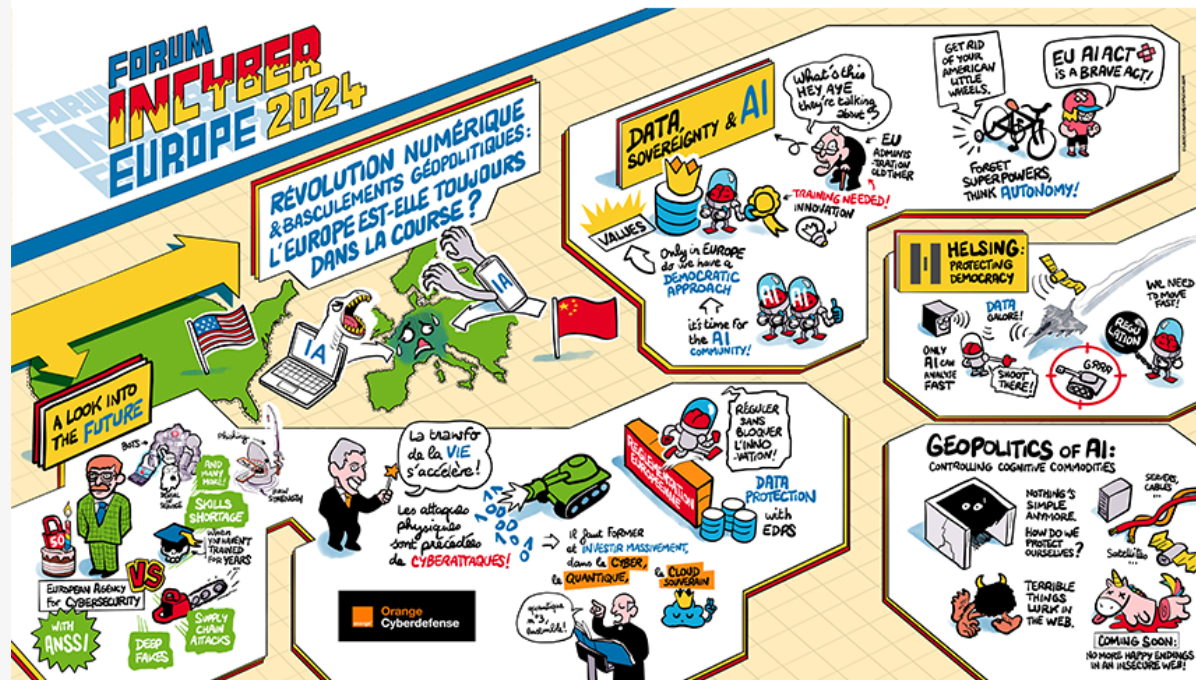
Cyberthreats : European elections under strict surveillance
